Data ataraga madia	CD-ROM, DVD, FTP, e-mail
Data storage media	
Data filing	Name every folder during data delivery or transmission and include all relevant data infor- mation.
File formats	 Create each document in an extra file. If possible, deliver print data on a 1:1 scale. Aspect ratios should be true to original. Final format +5 mm bleed all around. No register and cut marks. In the case of tiled or split graphics: deliver a drawing and/or sketch with position guidelines (dimensions and arrangement of individual graphic sections).
Colours	 Set up all colours as CMYK. Colours defined as Pantone, HKS, RAL or RGB mode normally do not correspond to the original colour when converted to CMYK and require consultation. Please create black as 4c black: 85c/80m/80y/100k. Printing on different materials influences the colour result.
Fonts	Please convert all fonts to vector paths.
Pictures	Please do not send us any linked pictures. All pictures have to be embedded.
Picture resolution	The appropriate final resolution depends on the particular observation distance and the motif. Based on experience, 5 pixel/mm = 125 dpi should be provided in the final format.
	In practice, however, this cannot always be realised; consequently the lowest limit for resolutions is 2 pixel/mm = 50 dpi.
	Practical example as assistance Final format of the printed matter: W 4100 x H 2850 mm Subject in the photo: W 8185 x H 5787 pixels
	4100 mm x 5 pixel/mm = 20.500 pixel width 2850 mm x 5 pixel/mm = 14.250 pixel height
